Campers learn the basics of beach safety and how to address emergencies such as cuts and broken limbs.

Campers design and play on their own mini golf course.



SWIMMING

Campers enjoy water games, swimming, pool noodles, paddle boards and jumping off our dock.

Campers build giant bubble rings, cubes and pyramids to create bubbles that float and bounce!



DRAMA

Campers perform in a talent show, puppetry, plays, comedy skits, singalongs and game shows.
