Our highly experienced coaches and counselors provide a safe, supportive, and engaging environment, with a special focus on fostering a love for the bay and preserving its natural beauty. A certified lifeguard patrols the waterfront, and all coaches are proud members of the Positive Coach Alliance—ensuring every child is encouraged to grow, learn, and thrive.

Tasty, nutritious lunches are available per session for a nominal fee, with careful attention given to allergies and dietary restrictions.

During their enrollment, campers and their parents are invited to Thursday Night Socials at the Boathouse, underscoring the warm and inclusive culture that the club has nurtured for almost a century. Camp enrollment is limited to 40 kids per session, organized into five groups of eight.
